ORDINANCE NO. 464

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 81-7 AND ADOPTING SECTIONS 320.106 THROUGH SECTION 320.190 EXCEPT PARAGRAPH 1 OF SECTION 320.151 OF CHAPTER 320, REVISED STATUTES OF MISSOURI, KNOWN AS THE "FIREWORKS REGULATION" AS AND FOR THE "FIREWORKS REGULATION ORDINANCE" OF THIS CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LEETON, JOHNSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Sections 320.106 through 320.151 RSMo known as the "Fireworks Regulation" is hereby adopted as and for the "Fireworks Regulation Ordinance" of this City with like effect as if recited at length herein, and as the same may be hereafter amended.

SECTION TWO: All existing ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Leeton in conflict with this "Fireworks Regulation Ordinance" are hereby repealed on the effective date hereof, and anything therein in conflict with this "Fireworks Regulation Ordinance" is hereby superceded by this "Fireworks Regulation Ordinance".

SECTION THREE: No person shall offer fireworks for sale to individuals at retail before the twentieth day of June and after the fifth day of July.

SECTION FOUR: It shall be unlawful for any person to use fireworks within the City of Leeton in a manner that could cause bodily harm or property damage.

SECTION FIVE: It shall be unlawful to use or discharge any firework except between the hours of 12:30 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on June 30 through July 7 each year.

SECTION SIX: Any individuals who shall violate this "Fireworks Regulation Ordinance" shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION SEVEN: This "Fireworks Regulation" Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage.
